Application for Student Travel Assistance Grant

The 19th ACM International Symposium on High Performance Distributed Computing, 2010 Chicago, Illinois -- June 20-25, 2010

A limited number of travel assistance grants are available from various sponsors of HPDC. Priority will be given to students who would otherwise be unable to attend the conference and to graduate students presenting their own published work. Notice of awards will be made prior to the conference. The grants will be distributed post-conference in the form of reimbursements against actual travel, registration and accommodations expenses submitted by the student. The amounts of the grants depend on the number of qualified applications and the amount of funds HPDC can commit to student travel grants. To qualify for the student travel grant assistance, a recipient must be a full-time student (undergraduate or graduate) registered at a US or international university. Students (especially undergraduates or early early-year graduate students) who have a paper co-authored at HPDC2010 are especially encouraged to apply.
